



Emergency Medical Technician

Description:

This 190 hour course is designed to prepare personnel to render pre-hospital basic life support services, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation, with emphasis on field application, practices, and techniques vital to the interaction of EMT-I personnel with all levels of emergency medical personnel. Students completing course will be prepared to take the NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS (NREMT) exam.
