ETHICAL LEADERSHIP IN THE CLASSROOM

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This one-day course is designed to provide you with concepts and theories of the ethical decision making process, help you recognize the signs of an ethical dilemma, identify advantages and disadvantages of ethical behavior, and an opportunity to review examples of classroom situations in which instructors used their leadership role to either encourage or discourage ethical behavior. Participants in this class will examine ethics, values, principles, and morality. State Fire Training's Instructor Code of Ethics/Conduct will also be presented.

INSTRUCTORS:

Chief Haas has been a public safety professional for more than 32 years. He holds a Master's Degree in Emergency Services Administration from California State University, Long Beach; a Bachelor's Degree in Management/Organizational Development from Saint Mary's College; and an Associate's Degree in Fire Science from San Joaquin Delta College. He is also a graduate of the National Fire Academy Executive Fire Officer Leadership Program.
