# Fire Inspector 1C/1D

## Field Inspection

### **Class Description:**

These are the third and fourth classes in a four-course series. Fire Inspector 1C provides students with a basic knowledge of field inspection roles and responsibilities of a Fire Inspector I including basic plan review, emergency access for an existing system, hazardous materials, and the operational readiness of fixed fire suppression systems, existing fire detection and alarm systems, and portable fire extinguishers. Fire Inspector 1D covers field inspection roles and responsibilities specific to California including tents, canopies, and temporary membrane structures; fireworks and explosives; and Wildland urban interface.

### **Instructor Bio:**

Howard Cooke's experience of more than 45 years in the fire service consist of Master Instructor (CSFM and U.S. Air Force), firefighter/paramedic, confined space instructor, investigator, heavy rescue, supervising fire inspector, and Community College teaching credentials (fire technology). Howard retired from the USAF after 22 years in fire suppression, fire training and fire investigations and also retired from the Sacramento Fire Department after 22 years in fire prevention as a supervising Fire Inspector.
