POST Certified RADAR and LIDAR OPERATOR COURSES

The San Bruno Police Department will be hosting POST certified operator courses for both RADAR and LIDAR from April 30, 2016 through May 3, 2016. There will be 16 seats in these classes open for outside agency registration and there is no tuition cost. Students are asked to bring RADAR and/or LIDAR devices from their agencies if possible. Portions of this class are conducted in the field, so suitable attire and footwear should be worn.

RADAR OPERATOR COURSE (24 HOURS)

Info: Students will develop skills in visual speed estimation and the actual operation of RADAR units. The course will also cover RADAR history, theory, effects, operations, courtroom testimony and case law. Upon completion of this course, officers will be certified to use RADAR devices to conduct speed enforcement.
