Class Description:

This course is designed for Single Resource Boss, Incident Commander Type 4, and Support Dispatcher. It covers aircraft capabilities, aviation management and safety, tactical and logistical uses of aircraft, and requirements for helicopter take-off and landing areas. Note: the regulations, procedures, and policies addressed in this course are primarily those governing federal agency and ICS operations. State, county, or other political subdivisions using this course will need to consult the agency having jurisdiction over their regulations, procedures, and policies.
